- 2. To work for the preservation of civil liberties for all and to fight any abridgement of the freedoms guaranteed all citizens under the United States Constitution.
- 3. To provide information on the history, purpose and methods of the H.C.U.A.
- 4. To present the trutha about what happened in San Francisco on May 12-14, 1960.
- 5. To help contribute financial aid to the defense of Robert Meisenbach.

The Executive Committee of our organization is composed of Burton White, Irving Hall, Clark Smith, Chris Murray, Larry Chase, Dick Albert, Patty Hall, Leslie Schoenfeld and Joan Bowman. We presently have over one hundred members from campuses throughout the Bay Area.
